Recognition and Onsite Events

Program participants will be recognized at the Plenary Sessions and at the Final Banquet. Additional recognition will be provided to identify participants on-site. A few tables will be set aside at the Final Banquet for those who wish to sit together.

Additionally, there will be a meetup session at the conference for PAG Mentors and First-Timers to meet and network, and a directory will be provided for those who wish to contact other program participants.

Information for PAG Mentors

Eligibility:

- ▶ You must be registered to attend PAG 30
- ▶ You must have attended at least 3 PAG meetings since 2015
- ▶ You must be attending PAG through Tuesday

As PAG Mentors, you are encouraged to:

- ▶ Be available to connect with your First-timer at least one week before the meeting (phone or zoom) to become familiar with the individual, learn about their goals, convey helpful hints, etc.
- ▶ Meet your First-timer at the conference meetup session, to answer any questions and/or discuss experiences.
- ▶ Introduce your First-timer to your colleagues at the conference
